



Health & Safety Policy

1. Statement of Intent

The aim of this policy is to help Cambridge Harriers to provide a healthy and safe environment for all members to enjoy our sport.

2. Responsibility for H & S

The Board has overall responsibility for creating a safe and healthy environment for the Club's activities, It should appoint a Health & Safety coordinator or working party to ensure this environment is created

3. Risk Assessments

The Coordinator or working party should conduct risk assessments of the club's facilities and activities and where needed generate guidelines to promote safe operation of the club's activities.

4. The Coordinator or Working Party

The coordinator or working party should communicate the guidelines to all officers, coaches, team managers, officials and volunteers and arrange training sessions where needed.

5. Evaluation

The coordinator or working party should review arrangements on an annual basis and report the results of this review to the Board.
